Whereas: Health care, education, economic development, and infrastructure problems in rural districts in Michigan need special attention from our legislature.

Whereas: Each rural district in Michigan has unique regional problems.

Whereas: Each region needs to accurately identify and prioritize the issues and seek local, regional, and statewide agreement on the problems and solutions addressing them.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The creation of the **Michigan Regional Rural Development Plan for Health Care, Education, Economic Development, and Infrastructure** to guide future legislation and serve as a template for the next five years. Each region’s plan will be finalized by Jan 2025.

The Regional Rural Development Plan must include two to three-day regional summits held in Congressional Districts 1,2, 4, 5, and 9 are to be accomplished before June 2024. The summit would include state and federal legislators, executive personnel, local/region subject member experts, and the general public. The results of the summits would formulate the Michigan Regional Rural Development Plan for each Rural District and be presented to the Governor and leaders of Michigan’s Senate and House of Representatives by Jan 2025

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That this resolution shall be forwarded to the State Democratic Party with the recommendation for its acceptance and placement in the appropriate document or with the appropriate committee for action.
